

IB World Student Conference Scholarship Instructions

Please read all instructions carefully. Failing to comply may result in the dismissal of your application.

A. Eligibility requirements

Applicants must be:

- A full Diploma Program student who is going to be an 11th grader in the fall of 2017. Special consideration may be given for a full DP student who will be a 12th grader in the fall of 2017.
- Able to demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- IB Scholarship recipients will be required to comply with the conditions of the scholarship, including, but not limited to the student:
 - Blogging and engaging in social media about the IB World Student
 - Conference before, during, and after the conference
 - Provide IB SOM with a presentation of the conference that will be shared with
 - Attend the fall symposium to give a presentation on experiences at the conference.

B. Completing the application

Applicants must complete and return all of the following documents as one PDF file:

1. **Application:** Please fill out all information below and answer all questions within the specified length requirements.
2. **IB School approval/concurrence:** Students are required to have the IB coordinator or school head approve your application for scholarship. Make sure they fill out the concurrence section below.
3. **Essay:** Write a one page essay on what attending an IB World Student Conference would mean to you and what you hope to gain from the experience.
4. **Evidence of financial need:** Please provide evidence for financial need including but not limited to a statement from IB coordinator, teacher and/or head of school. **Costs covered:** conference fee, travel to and from the airport where the conference is located,

and airfare not to exceed a total cost of \$1,800. **Costs not covered:** any additional nights accommodations, travel to and from the Detroit airport, and personal expenses.
